then use signs about who can navigate this area, shapes left in the water



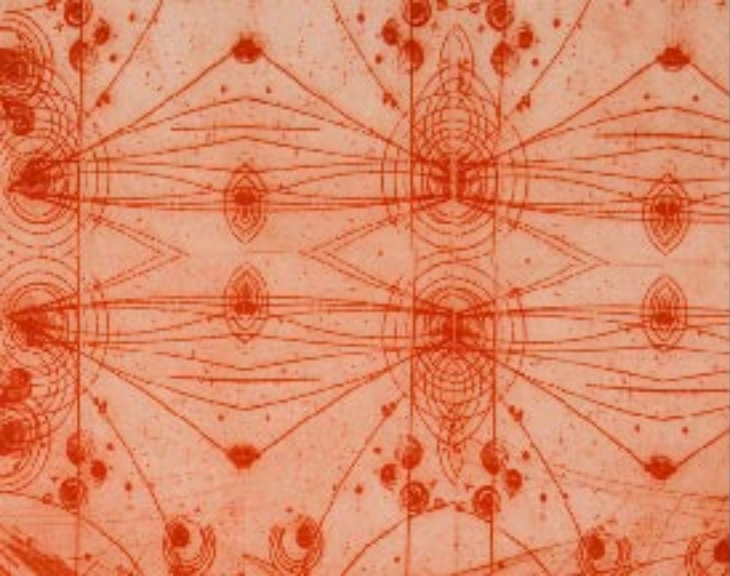
passed on

leaping across each other, mirrored in a frantic passage, the heart chamber





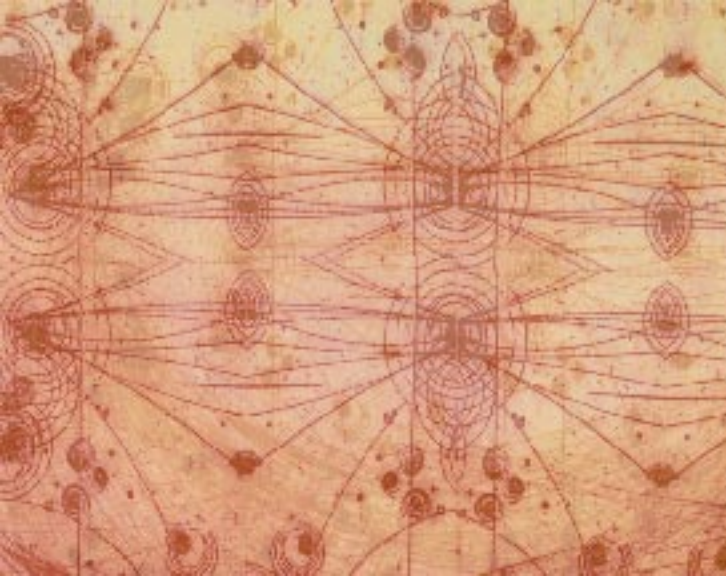


EMERGENCY

fills some who leave the emergency eating frenzy; others continue to move

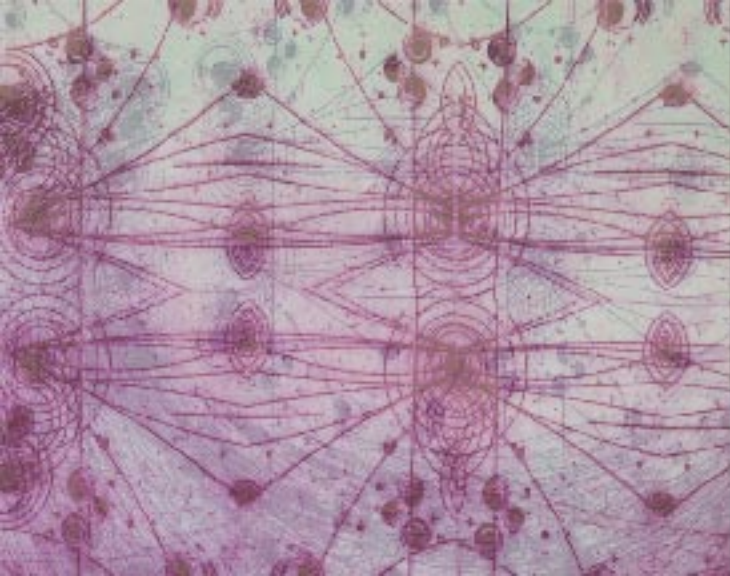

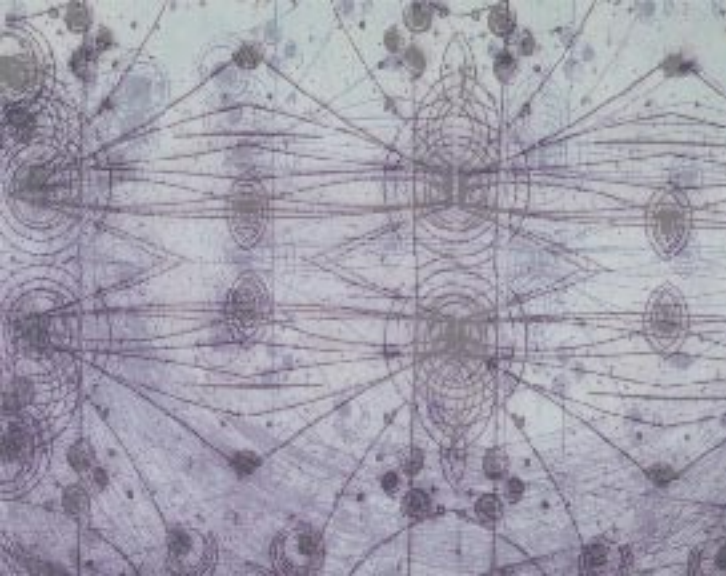
